

The replacement subsidy covers the hours of teaching as indicated in the applicant's employment contract. For example, a junior applicant with a 0.6 fte teaching duty can apply for a replacement subsidy of $0.6 * \in 3000 = £ 1,800$ per month. Payment of the replacement subsidy will be directly to the university or research institution involved. Research hours will not be compensated.
