



NIAS policy on accepting donations

NIAS-KNAW promotes curiosity-driven research for established and early career scholars. We are an intellectual haven where scholars, artists, writers and journalists come together in an interdisciplinary and collaborative environment. NIAS is committed to academic freedoms. We publicly advocate their urgency, and offer time and space for untied and undisturbed research.

Partnerships with (individual) donors as well as national and international foundations can help us realise our mission. Therefore NIAS wants to define the principles that apply when accepting a donation.

A 'donation' to NIAS is generally speaking a financial gift or legacy, but may also take another shape.

1. Donations of up to € 1,000 (single donation, or consecutive donations per year) are screened and can be accepted / not accepted without involvement of the NIAS directorate.
2. Above this amount, the NIAS directorate will determine whether donations are in agreement with relevant guidelines and codes. When accepting a donation they consider whether a donation is consistent with the vision and mission of the organization, and in accordance with developments in society.
3. NIAS accepts donations on the basis of what is in the organisation's interest, and the possible impact of a donation on staff, fellows and other stakeholders. NIAS always puts its independence first, and will not accept donations that harm or jeopardise its vision and mission.
4. NIAS will screen donors and donations (using information from the public domain) before making a decision to accept or not.
5. Anonymous or cash gifts are not accepted.
